When the Hunters came back from the UK and went to collect their animals, they were very upset to find that they had gone. With the help of the police they tried to find their three pets, but decided that they had probably died in the wild Canadian countryside. The Hunters then went to their cottage by a beautiful lake, and they found the animals there in the forest, waiting for them. They had travelled 400 kilometres to get there!
